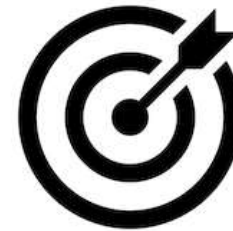

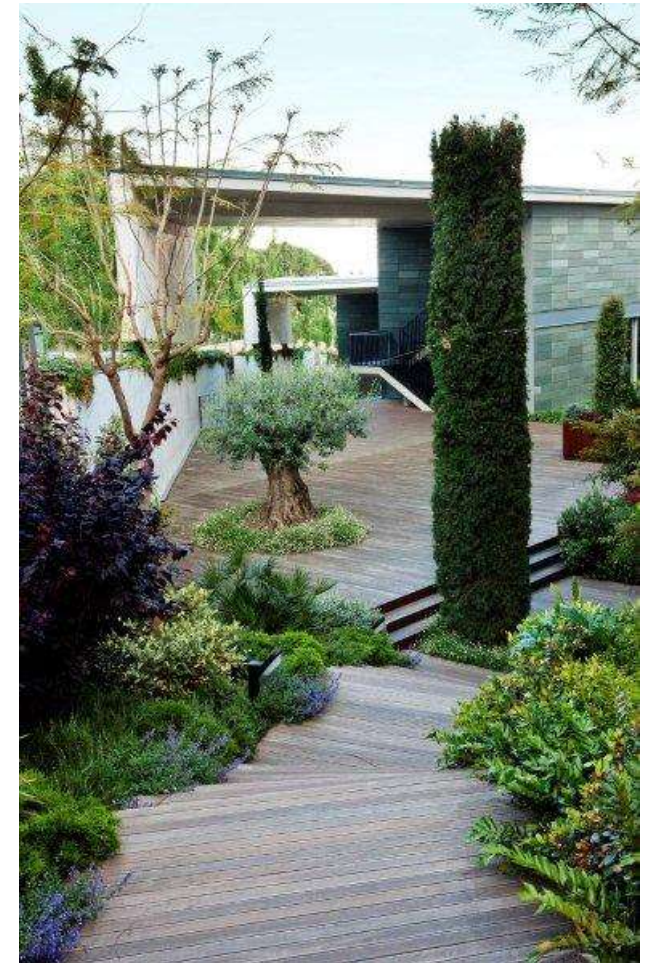

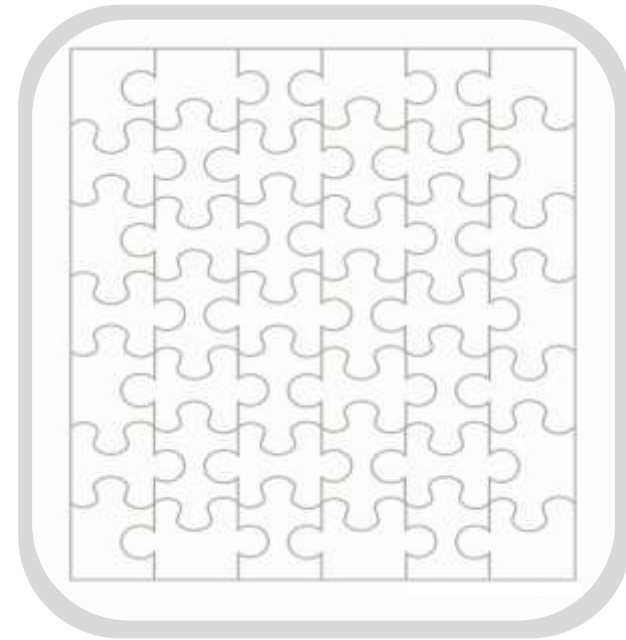

Why with us?

Where?

Barcelona is an amazing city with never-ending treasures, pleasures, beach, **monuments, sun...**

When?

July and August

(Please check starting dates).

To whom is addressed to?

People who want to learn Spanish in a quality program and to have fun.

I am 16, may I enroll?

The program is for adults (at least 18 years-old) or 16-17 years-old accompanied by an adult. For 16-17 years-old students coming on their own, please consult as you must enroll through a partner.

Can I come on my own?

Yes! **We'll allocate you with** another student of the same gender.

Groups?

You are all welcome, please call us!

How far are you from city center?

29 minutes by metro/train to city centre (Plaza Catalunya).

Who organize this?

Residència Universitària Sarrià, a Student University hall working since 1999 together with BCNBABEL, a Language Academy working since 2012.

Can I enroll for just one week?

We're sorry to inform you can't. The classes are prepared in a two week basis. You can book housing only out of the language program.

Can I book a single room?

Yes, with an extra charge!

The Full description



The Sarrià Residence Hall first opened in 1999 to offer accommodation for university students. Since 2009, we organize highly successful intensive Spanish language courses during the summer. This year we have joined BCNBABEL to organize a new intensive course including activities.

A 30% deposit will be required to reserve a spot. The remaining fee will be paid one month in advance.

Individuals joining the course on their own are welcome as well!

Dates:

Through August, starting on July 26th. The program is organized to last two weeks, each starting on Sunday (classes start on Monday). Extra nights have an extra cost that can be added before or after the course.

What's included:

- Accommodation for 14 nights in a shared double room (minimum stay). Room cleaning twice a week, linen and towels included.
- Full board during the whole stay.
- You can use all the facilities listed at the Residence Hall Sarrià.
- Three hours of Spanish lessons per day, from Monday to Friday, at the Residence Hall, for basic, intermediate and advanced levels.
- Pleasant lessons delivered by a specialised teacher guaranteed by BCNBABEL. If you wish to do some further studying, extra work can be arranged.
- 8 Activities and trips, from Monday to Thursday, which allows you to combine what you have learnt and to have fun.
- Transport trips one way are included (with public transport). Sitges trip includes a private bus round trip.
- The lessons include a cooking day, where you will learn to prepare typical dishes and continue to learn Spanish by focusing on the specific terms.
- Optional Movie sessions arranged, with Spanish films, subtitled in English at our cinema room.

Facilities:

Included: Cinema room, swimming pool at the rooftop with solarium, ping pong table, foosball, TV room, sport center (in front of the Residence), study rooms, CCTV, 24 hours reception.

Not included but available: laundry service and laundry self-service, car and motorcycle parking, vending machines, pool table.

Details:

- The program is aimed for adults (over 18 on the start day of the activity). Underage individuals from the age of 16 may also join the program but must be accompanied by an adult at all times, holding legal guardianship documents.
- If you travel alone you will share the room with one of your classmates of the same gender.
- Flight tickets, transfers or public transportation are not included.
- The Residence Hall is well connected by public transport, bus and train running 24 hours.
- The Residence Hall has the right to cancel the program if a minimum number of students is not reached. In this event, all enrolled students will be informed one month in advance and offered a special price for accommodation without the language lessons.
- All registered students must pay 30% of the price of the stay as a retainer. The rest of the fee will be paid 30 days before the arrival, as a way to confirm the booking. Payments can be made via bank transfer or credit card. Payments are essential in order to arrange the bookings for the activities.
Additional cost per extra nights: please enquire.

Price:

€ 1,450

Price per person for a 14 nights accommodation. Includes taxes, Spanish lessons, activities and all services listed.

What is not included:

Photocopies out of the classes material, parking, personal clothes washing or vending machines products.

Details of the activities

What the trips include:

- **One-way tickets for the program's activities. Some round trips are included**, as some are outside the city.
- The trips can be extended, but the ticket will be paid by the students **themselves. For example, a trip to Gaudí's Palau Güell** (included) can be combined with a visit to Casa Batllò (not included), which is within walking distance.
- Activities and trips are from Monday to Thursday. Friday and weekends are for your free time.
- Some day trips include picnic service.
- If for some reason a trip needs to be changed, it will be replaced by another similar trip from a list of confirmed trips that will be sent to the students a month before the program starts.

The trips



We have an incredible allocation in Barcelona from where you will enjoy of exiting trips and activities included in the program.

Here are the places we will visit:



Barceloneta beach

Located in the traditional fishing district, Barceloneta is a classic neighborhood in Barcelona, where the people of Barcelona like to come and eat fish and seafood dishes and "tapas".



Tapas at Blai street

The most traditional variety of tapas in Barcelona is served in the Blai Street, one of the most popular streets in the neighborhood of Poble Sec and a wonderful option to go on a Sunday afternoon. It is one of the main tapas streets in Barcelona, and the most famous one has specialties in anchovy tapas bar.



Museum Cau Ferrat

The Cau Ferrat Museum was founded in 1930 by the artist's nephew, Josep Lluís Ferrat, as a home workshop and became a public museum in 1933. It is a living tribute to the artist's spirit inspired by his founder.



Fundació Miró

The Fundació Joan Miró was created by Miró himself, at first privately with works from his own private collection, with a desire to set up an internationally recognized centre in Barcelona for Miró scholarship and contemporary art research, and to disseminate the collection.



Wine tasting at Gràcia neighborhood

Gràcia is a fascinating experience, but another is a foodie destination. With a strong focus on human bonds and traditions.



Museu Nacional MNAC

The Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya is a national museum in Catalonia, located in Barcelona, Catalonia. The museum is especially notable for its outstanding collection of Romanesque church paintings, and for Catalan art and design from the late 19th and early 20th centuries, including modernism and noucentisme.



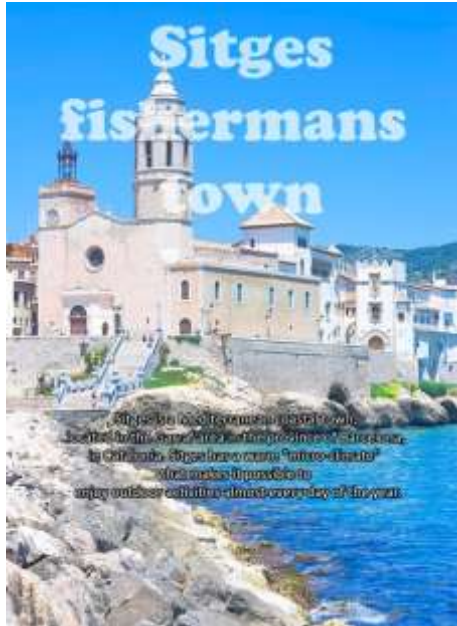
Modernism at Passeig de Gràcia

The Picasso museum is a key reference for understanding the formative years of Pablo Picasso. The genius of the young artist is revealed through the 4,251 works that make up the permanent collection.



Sitges fishermans town

Sitges is a lovely coastal town with beautiful beaches, a marina and the possibility of staying in a charming Sitges house or a "turris-delta" which makes it possible to enjoy outdoor activities almost every day of the year.



Telefèric Muntanya Barcelona

The Telefèric offers a special thanks to its visitors: a route allows you to enjoy unparalleled views, adding to your journey in the Montjuïc Castle, on the top of which you can find the representation of the city's history.



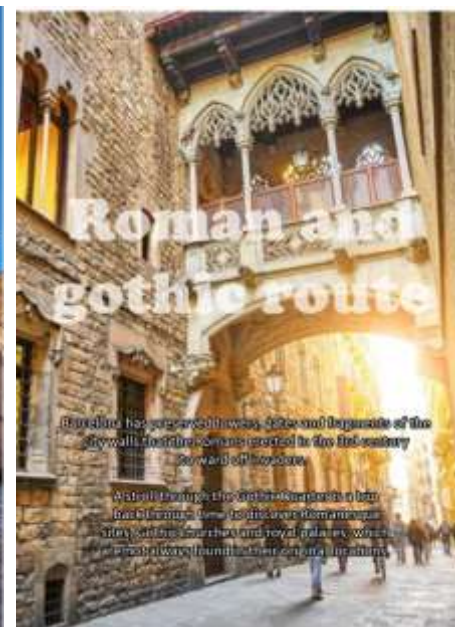
Palau Güell

Palau Güell was one of the first important commissions Antoni Gaudí received at the start of his career. Lluís Güell (industrialist, politician and patron of the arts) wanted Gaudí to build him the "Residència Güell" as an extension of the family home on La Rambla.



Santa Maria del Mar church

Santa Maria del Mar is a church in the urban district of Barceloneta, built between 1899 and 1908. It is an outstanding example of Catalan Gothic with a purely neogothic style and neo-gothic facade buildings.



Roman and gothic route

Barcelona has preserved its walls, towers and fragments of the city walls to date. It was created in the 1st century forward of towers.

When through the street you pass a lot of the Roman ruins, as the case of Roman aqueducts, the church and royal palace, which are always found in the same location.
